

- Tim Hill will be playing a Euphonium olo for our Ministry of Music. The Mission War Song is an apocalyptic hymn written in 1874 by George Scott Railton to the ancient Welsh tune called Harlech. It vividly portrays the battle between God and sin and invites the listener to resist temptation and join the conflict as a soldier for Christ. The lyrics can be found at https://hymnary.org/media/fetch/190681. Tim is playing this piece on a euphonium which is a brass instrument with a large, conical bore similar to a tuba or a flugelhorn, but a vocal range similar to a trombone or baritone. Euphoniums are commonly played as the tenor voice in military brass bands.
