▪ **Next Sabbath, we will return to having two worship services**, 8:45 and 11:15 AM, with Bible study classes beginning at 10:00 AM.

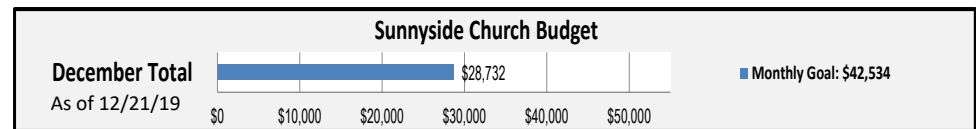
