


The Story of Sunnyside's Rieger Organ - Part 1

I am grateful to Dr. Wilfred Geschke for collecting the following memories of Sunnyside's Rieger Organ acquisition:



Mel West who had not yet moved to Portland. His suggestion was that we visit Pacific Union College and listen to their Rieger organ which we did. When we arrived there we were delighted to discover that on the same weekend a visiting organ virtuoso from New





York was scheduled to give a concert. What we heard was



deeply inspiring. That event led to a decision to order a Rieger organ which is made in Austria by a family that has an organ making tradition going back over 100 years. Measurements were taken by the company, component parts hand crafted and then



shipment to Sunnyside from Austria was accomplished. It took several months for installation and the workmen were kindly housed by Duanne and Eunice Bietz who at that time lived on Mt Tabor.

The story of our Rieger organ has a number of perspectives. I am collecting these and intend to share them in future Communiqués. WATCH THIS SPACE!

In the meantime we thank God for the many ways worship happens, for His provision of instruments to praise Him and, especially, for those who allow Him to minister through them, for their talents and commitment.


