Happy New Year Church Family!

I pray that the first week of 2022 has been a blessing for you and your family. Pastor Mark recently posted on Facebook about New Year's resolutions. I LOVE New Year's resolutions! It has always been a way to keep me motivated, to stay healthy, to be a better husband and friend. Most of the time they don't last but every year I keep making them. If you have

resolutions this year let me know what yours are and we can try to keep each other accountable for what we hope to achieve in 2022.

Back to Pastor Mark's Facebook post.' He was mentioning that the best New Years resolution you can have is to make this world a better place in 2022 than it was in 2021. While I really do like New Year's resolutions, I would have to agree that this would be the ultimate resolution. It makes me think of the phrase, "Leave it better than you found it." The original quote came from Lord Robert Baden -Powell's farewell Message in 1941. Baden-Powell was the founder of *Scouting* and he is quoted as follows, "Try and leave this world a little better than you found it, and when your turn comes to die, you can die happy in feeling that at any rate, you have not wasted your time but have done your best."

I like that. In Romans 12:1-2, Paul gives us great ways to leave the world a better place than when we found it. Using The Message paraphrase we read, "So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going -to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you."

Paul tells us here that to leave the world a better place than when we found it, this is what we should do:

- We should take the ordinary actions of life and present them as an offering to God.
- 2. Embrace that what God does for us is the best thing that we can do for him.
- 3. Don't conform so easily to our culture.
- 4. Fix our attention on God and be transformed.
- 5. Recognize what he wants from you and do it quickly.
- 6. Develop well-formed maturity with the help of God.

So, if we were to take these six things Paul tells us to do to transform ourselves as well as the world around us, what would your resolutions look like now?

Here is my challenge for you. Find one way for each of Paul's advice, six in total. This will give you six New Year's resolutions to make the world in 2022 better than 2021. And you can be happy at the end of 2022 that you have not wasted your time, but you have done your best.

It is my prayer, and the prayer of the Sunnyside staff, that our church be a place where the members of this church create a better world today, and the lives of people who may not know Jesus Christ learn who He is, and say that they are better for it. Here's to 2022!
