Hi Sunnyside family,

I'm back from an amazing whirlwind trip with my sister through the North Cascades and Canadian Rockies. We were greeted by the stunning colors of fall—golden larch trees shedding their needles and turning the alpine landscape into a vibrant wonderland of yellow against the deep green forests.

We've been chasing auroras long before they blew up on social media. While in the Rockies last week, I got a notification on my phone about an expected solar impact. Unfortunately, we were stuck under thick clouds in Golden, BC. We soon discovered that the timing of the impact was delayed, so we didn't end up missing much. The next day, we headed to Banff, AB, and that's when the Coronal Mass Ejection (CME) finally hit earth! That evening we were treated to the most incredible full-sky aurora I'd ever witnessed...until Thursday rolled around!

Last Thursday morning, I got a notification that more auroras were on the way—the fast-moving, Earth-facing CME's from the sun were headed right for us. Perfect timing! I spent the day watching aurora webcams from around the world, eagerly counting down the hours until nightfall. As evening rolled in, the skies cleared, the air was cool and crisp and we set up our camera gear on a small rock outcrop on the shore of Lake Minnewanka. For the next six hours (in belowfreezing temps!), we were treated to an even better aurora show! My sister and I felt like kids, necks craned, shouting, "Oooh! Ahhh! Look at that!" as a vibrant, full-sky aurora danced overhead. We finally went back to our accommodation at 2 AM, while the lights were still going strong, even into sunrise. The conditions were perfect. Other photographers I met that night were saying it was one of the most brilliant, diverse displays they had ever seen. Everything aligned for a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

I'm so grateful we were in Banff, AB, that night instead of Golden, BC. I'm so grateful that the skies in Banff were perfectly clear. I'm so grateful my sister was there with me to share in the awe. I'm so grateful that the sun decided to release a massive solar storm (the 6th strongest since 1996!) while we happened to be visiting. Everything aligned.

There's so much going on in the world right now, and probably in your life too. Keep looking up—God has a way of aligning things in His time, and when He does, it'll leave you awestruck.






