Hi Sunnyside Family,

When was the last time you lived between a high ending and an uncertain beginning?

That's how I feel during the time between Christmas and New Year's – the liminal space partially filled with internal chaotic energy fueled by the euphoria of "new" New Year's resolutions (read "unaccomplished resolutions in 2025") and an ambient peace knowing that my life is under the lordship of Jesus.

I'm spending Christmas and New Year's with my in-laws in Riverside, California, this weekend. This will be the first Christmas without my abuela and abuelita – the grandparents of my wife – whose funerals I conducted this year. As I walk around mom and dad's house, and have arros y frijoles, with Cuban flan at the dinner table, I'm reminded of the people who should have been here but aren't. The liminal space is a hard place, forcing me to confront the fear of grief and the uncertainties of a future without them.

But the days after the birth of Jesus reminds me that though the path ahead is jagged, scary, and overwhelming, God's purposes will prevail. The plans of God speak louder than the fears of my life. That although suffering may endure through the night, joy comes in the morning.

That's probably why C.S Lewis in "A Grief Observed" penned these words after the death of his wife: "My idea of God is not a divine idea. It has to be shattered time after time. He shatters it Himself. The Incarnation is the supreme example; it leaves all previous ideas of the Messiah in ruins. And most are "ffended" by the iconoclasm; and blessed are those who are not."

Jesus, we believe, is the reason for the season. And for Lewis, and to us we allow it to be; the days following Christmas can be a season in which the reasons for why we orient our lives towards God can be reexamined and revisited.

Here's to more clarity amidst confusion, and hope amidst despair, in our own liminal spaces.


Sunnyside Church office will be closed for the holidays from December 18-January 5. If you have something urgent during this time, please contact us via text at 971-238-9680.

Adventist Health Portland needs your help making comfort shawls.


What is a comfort shawl?




