One of the most startling images of the Christmas story occurs in the book of Revelation. This gruesome description reminds us that, to echo C.S. Lewis' words, the birth of Christ was an invasion of occupied enemy territory. Yet, while we wait for the final moment where victory manifests with Jesus' return, there are still "dragons" that seek devour the presence of Jesus in our life. These dragons have an infinite number of appearances (greed, critical spirits harsh words, violence, etc.). In a world full of dragons, we need reminders that, while the darkness sought to overcome the light of Jesus "the darkness did not overcome it" (John 1:5).

This season, be mindful of those dragons that seek to devour the light in our lives. Fight back by holding to the truth of Christ's victory and a refusal to become a dragon in our words and actions towards others.


Christmas Evensong will be on December 20, at 4:00 PM, here at Sunnyside Adventist Church. The program will feature arrangements of holiday favorites from J.S. Bach and Brahms, as well as recent works by Melvin West and Paul Fey (an arrangement of the Widor Toccata combined with O Come All Ye Faithful). Also included will be singing of several favorite carols and an improvisation by the organist. The full range of sounds from the Rieger organ will be featured, from the quietest whisper to the thundering full organ. It will be presented by Michael Koller on the organ. Loren Dickinson with the spoken word, and Elynn Rodriguez. Several of the selections were arranged by Melvin West. Loren Dickinson and Melvin West lived next door to each other for some 12 years during their teaching careers at Walla Walla College (now University). It was during their many gab sessions that the idea of this vesper-type service, Evensong, was born. Doctor Dickinson was looking for an opportunity to present some of the wonderful gems of literature, while at the same time Doctor West was exploring the possibility of a vesper-type program with the organist providing several compositions, but relieved by readings from literature. So it seemed a natural to create an EVENSONG program in which the organ music was separated by selections from literature.


Wednesday mornings at 10:00 our Men's Bible Study group meet to study the Bible together in the Youth Room. Men, you are all invited to join us for this weekly study.
