Last Friday, Liesl and Isaac – parents of Koen, Marya, Naeema, and Adam – joined me on a scouting trip to Tillamook to preview the house and venues for our first-ever spring break youth retreat (March 27–29). We’re also looking forward to a special highlight that weekend: our youth will be taking over the worship service at Tillamook SDA Church. With 45 registered participants and chaperones, excitement is building. Please keep us in prayer!
