Hello, Sunnyside Family,

A huge thank you to everyone involved in our Easter program! To the visioners, musicians, AV team, worship coordinators, and everyone working behind the scenes: we are SO grateful. Thank you also to those who helped with our potluck lunch. It could not have happened without you!

It brought me so much joy to watch our children's choir perform their first piece under Chaplain Tino. For some, singing for a packed church was intimidating, but that stretch is where real growth begins. In their brave voices, I heard a reminder of the courage we often trade for routine as adults. These children showed us that growth does not have to stop with age. Stepping outside your comfort zone to serve is a gift to the church and essential for your own wellbeing.

It may sound counterintuitive, but taking measured risks actually reduces stress. By getting comfortable with discomfort, you train your brain to handle life's curveballs. Trying something new stimulates neuroplasticity, keeping your mind sharp and preventing stagnation. These experiences activate curiosity and release a dopamine boost that supports your motivation.

Routine puts the brain on cruise control, but serving in a new capacity forces you to adapt. This can reveal gifts for leadership or hospitality you never knew existed. Every time you step out of the pew and into service, you grow your resilience and build the self esteem needed for even bigger goals.

If our kids can sing their hearts out in front of a full church, we can certainly step out of our routines. By serving, we are not just giving time; we are choosing a more resilient mind. Find a new way to serve this week. If you are not sure where to start, come chat with one of your pastors.
