Hi Sunnyside Family,

Last week I was at Walla Walla University speaking for their Spring Week of Worship. I did 5 talks under the theme “Brewed for Belonging” where we explored what it could mean to belong to ourselves, belong to one another, and belong to God through the Way of Christ, illustrated through the metaphor of chai-making.

The week culminated in a Friday night “chaixperience” where I, along with a few student helpers, made masala chai (from scratch!) for around 400+ students and staff. It was a pleasure to introduce them to ancestral chai flavors that may, or may not, challenge their tastebuds for future chai experiences 😊 It was also a joy connecting with some of our PAA / Sunnyside graduates who are current students there.

Our current main priority at Sunnyside for our student ministries (18-30) is to coordinate and facilitate baptismal studies for 22 students between now and the end of summer. We are also gearing up for a packed summer itinerary with Sunnyside and Oregon Conference events.

In times like these where we feel a sense of excitement and momentum in our community, I'm reminded of one of many quotes from my late grandfather-in-law, Dr. Jose Fuentes, who described the church, as neither a “museum” for saints, nor a “hospital” for sinners, but a “laboratory” of reconciling love where we are tasked with “improving the formula for our ultimate existence in heaven with one another.” The community of Christ is where we do the sometimes difficult yet important work of bringing all of who we are, seeking to understand each other, and journeying together towards unity in diversity.

Looking forward to worshipping with you today as we continue our study on Ephesians.
