
What is a comfort shawl?

March Camp Meeting Fundraising Numbers are in and Guess What...They're looking Really Good!

As you may have heard, Gladstone Camp Meeting will return in 2025! We would like to thank everyone who contributed to making this wonderful event possible. While it has taken a few weeks to get numbers tallied from March, we are pleased to report that we truly saw the windows of heaven open to provide a great blessing toward th effort! This gave our administrative team the confidence to move forward with the event and begin to secure the necessary labor and materials needed to bring it all together.

Last time we gave you an update, we had received \$147,000 towards our goal with \$43,000 of this amount being matched funds. During the month of March, we received significant donations that have allowed us to take full advantage of the remainder of all \$150,000 of matching funds! In total, we have received around \$385,000 for camp meeting! This puts us within \$5,000 of our fundraising goal!
