# Greetings Sunnyside Family!

Summer is here and the wildflowers are out in full bloom in and around the Gorge. I've enjoyed seeing their vibrant colors on different trails; from the white trilliums to the purple cow's clover, the red Indian paintbrushes, the orange Columbia Tigerlilies...the list goes on! Different flowers bloom at different times

geographically too; I found it fascinating that the balsamroot peaks much earlier on the Moiser plateau compared to those on Dog Mountain.

Spring ephemeral blooms are short-lived each year. During the winter months, these plants look barren and are void of anything resembling a vibrantly colored flower; we sometimes may mistakenly think that nothing is happening during this time. However, did you know that many plants need a period of "vernalization" or a "chill period?" Yes, flowers need chill time! Many flowering plants must go through a prolonged period of cold in order to blossom or germinate in the spring. We wouldn't have the bright and beautiful wildflowers we enjoy in May-July around the Gorge if we didn't have our cold PNW winters.

We have a tendency to look for the blooms. It's uncommon for someone to bring their loved one a bunch of buds; they'd rather give them a bunch of beautiful, bright, blooming flowers! In life too, we often get frustrated during winters, especially if winter lasts longer than anticipated. However, what if we realized the value of winters? We need winters in order for spring blossoms to appear. As King Solomon eloquently expressed, *"To everything there is a season..."* (Ecclesiastes 3:1)

As we're planning our children's ministry calendar for the year, I am looking forward to seeing our ministry bloom! However, I also recognize that in order to blossom, there will be a time of germination (aka intentional prayer and planning.) Please continue to uplift our Children's Ministries Team in your prayers. We can't wait to see what God has in store for us this upcoming year.
