PLAN PROGRESS:

Phase 1 Field Preparation is almost complete! We are excited to report that the contractor (MEI) is finishing the initial grade this week.

Phase 2 - Irrigation System. We are planning to begin next week (June 2-6) on the layout of the irrigation for the field. WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Phase 3 -Boring City Water Hook Up. Hook up the school and the church to

Hook up the school and the church to Boring City Water (June 16-20) WE NEED YOUR HELP! Phase 4 - Plant (Hydro-Mulch) Contractor will be spraying the field. It takes about 2 months for the seed to germinate and for the field to be ready to use. GOAL - Our goal is to have the new field planted no later than the first week of July!

Phase 5 - Field setup complete New goals and nets, ready for the Fall Soccer Season (September)
