Hi Sunnyside Family,

Elynn and I are thrilled to be back with you all after being away in Sri Lanka for the past 3 weeks on our inaugural Cross Culture Tour a hybrid-mission-culture tour that was made possible, largely in part, by your generosity and prayers. Twelve people from different parts of the U.S. with different backgrounds

were able to journey together on a 10-day paradigm-shifting, culturally-rich, experience of a lifetime that we're still processing days later.

Because of the generosity of Sunnysiders, we were able to match existing funds and renovate a portion of the Gartmore Tamil School that educates children of marginalized tea plantation workers in the hill country state of Maskeliya. It is indeed an amazing thought to know that a few thousand miles away, in a small village on a tiny island, the name of our church is forever memorialized in an important space that will outlive all of us! We are already scheming and planning for next year's trip so stay tuned for more information on that in the coming weeks.

Despite the jet lag and exhaustion, I surprised myself when I felt joy about coming to our staff meeting this Tuesday. What a privilege it is to not only enjoy the work you do but also the company of your colleagues! Working with pastors Seth, Rose, and Violeta, and our administrational superhero, Rosie, has been exciting and inspiring. I'm looking forward to our staff retreat in a few weeks where we will be dreaming and planning about how we can serve this wonderful community even better in the coming years.

Looking forward to worshiping with you this Sabbath. If you bump into me this Sabbath, say, "kohomadha" to me (pronounced "kohho-muh-dhuh" which means "how are you?" in Sinhala). You'll not only make my day but also might secretly solidify your position in my heart as a member in good standing who reads our weekly communique :-)






