We have made it safely home from Romania! Thank you for the prayers and support provided as we presented educational seminars to multiple congregations. We experienced powerful conversations and were invited to offer coaching for several challenging dynamics to help facilitate healing.

I am admittedly jet-lagged, but I am looking forward to being in the pulpit this Sabbath to share stories from Romania and a message on finding God's will.

Next weekend (August 22) marks the NPUC Pastors' Meetings and Constituency Session. Pastor Violeta and I will serve as delegates. We solicit your prayers as we worship together, explore the realities of ministry in the PNW, and vote on important decisions on August 24.

It is difficult to summarize the adventures of the last few weeks in a few words, but one simple truth reappeared throughout our travels: the universal need for redemption. All of us fall short (Romans 3:23) and require grace. Sometimes the path to redemption involves the natural consequences of our actions; however, when we "awake" from the mess and realize our need to get right, it is vital to have a community that does not define us by our worst moments. We need a community that holds us accountable as we are transformed by the grace of Jesus.

May you extend grace to those who need it this week—including yourself.

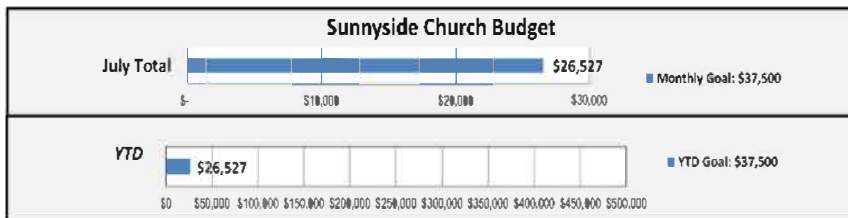

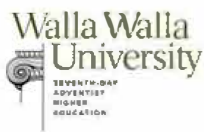
