Wednesday mornings at 10:00 our Men's Bible Study group meet to study the Bible together in the Youth Room. Men, you are all invited to join us for this weekly study.




Our history class meets on Tuesdays at 7:00 pm, in the Sandy Room. We will study "The Holy Land Revealed."



Do you knit or crochet? Adventist Health Portland needs your help making comfort shawls.


What is a comfort shawl?
