Hi Sunnyside Family,

Last week, I shared a conversation with a mother who was excited to share a voice note she received from her daughter during the final days of the Pathfinder Camporee. In the message, this Pathfinder enthusiastically described her life-changing experience at

Camporee sharing how she sensed the Holy Spirit at work in her heart. She excitedly shared that she had a deeper walk with Jesus and was coming home "different" to who she was before. If this mother had never shared her story, we might never have known the profound impact Camporee had on her daughter's spiritual journey.

Have you ever had a conversation where someone told you how much you impacted their life long after the moment had passed? Or maybe when you left a job, you received a card filled with heartfelt words about the meaningful ways you touched others? So often, we are unaware of the influence we have on others and how God is working in the details—a smile offered when someone felt low, a word of encouragement when they were ready to give up, a helping hand arriving just in time, or simply being present when no words were needed, not realizing how much your presence meant.

So much often goes unsaid, and perhaps it's time to change that narrative.

Here's your (easy!) challenge for the week: Think back to a time when someone's presence, words, smile, or act of kindness changed your outlook—and make the effort to tell them!

Proverbs 16:24 says, "Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the bones." (NKJV)

Send a card, voice note, or text message...if you want to, get creative! Share your story. Share your gratitude. Not only will recalling the moment uplift the other person, but you will find your spirit lifted as well.

From the desk of Pastor Violeta

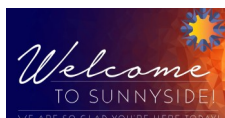
Hi Sunnyside Family,

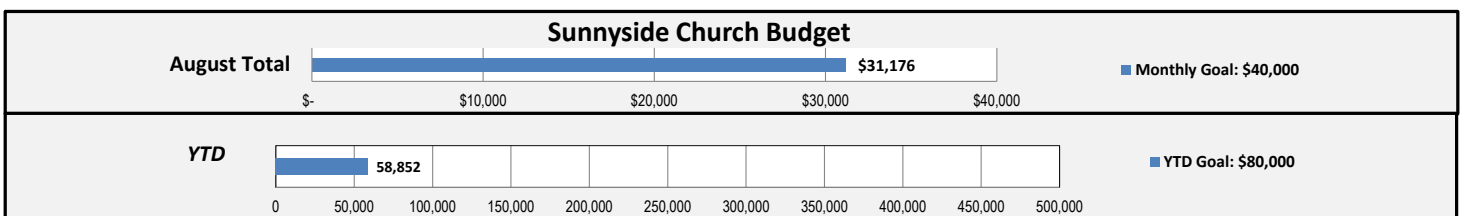

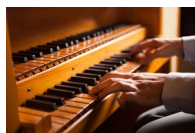
