Hello Sunnyside Family,

Do you know what a snipe is? What about snipe hunting?

Many years ago during a church campout we had an energetic young man who needed something to do. So, we sent him on a snipe hunt. A snipe, for those who are unfamiliar with the term, is a non-existent creature who lives in the woods. It was created by adults who needed some peace and quiet from rambunctious kids.

After explaining the need for stealth and handing the kid a bag, he occupied himself for 30 minutes to an hour looking for the elusive snipe. I didn't think it would work so well, and felt a little guilty as his parents asked me whathe was doing. When I sheepishly explained, they seemed amused and allowed it to continue. I still feel a little bad that the only thing he found at the end of his hunt was disappointment.

Adults go on snipe hunts too. Often they involve looking for the origin of rumors, looking for reasons to justify holding grudges, or explanations for why things went wrong even though we did everything right. Sometimes these snipe hunts are inspired by someone coming up to us and telling us where we should put our energies. This week, reflect the reminder that Jesus gives, "But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well" (Matthew 6:33). What kinds of snipe hunt have you been on that you need to let go? Where can you put Jesus and His kingdom first?

This Sabbath I am beginning a 3-part series exploring ways our focus gets thrown off of Jesus and onto other things. The first message is called "Chasing Fables." Hope to see you there!


Our history class meets on Tuesdays at 7:00 pm, in the Sandy Room. We will study "The Holy Land Revealed."


