Some key highlights of my time in the motherland thus far:

We successfully completed our second annual cross culture tours. Last year we had 9 people join us. This year we hac a slight bump of 34, that included 4 families with kids ages ranging from 3 to 14. Every day was a highlight, but the cherry on top of our 10-day excursion of the island has to be the opening of a student computer lab in one of the remote villages of the tea plantation worker community of Maskeliya. We were unaware that these were the first computers for not only this school but the entire region! Praising God for the blessing of innovative education and lif change for generations to come for this marginalized community.

I was selected to be this year's closer for TEDxColombo – the largest stage for ideas in Sri Lanka. I spoke for 16 mins (a world record!) under the title "Why your next cup of chai might change your life" bringing concepts of my book "Th Way of Chai" to life with examples from my pastoral ministry and social entrepreneurship ventures. Felt very grateful to be on stage with other Lankans who are changing the world in their own unique ways.

I had the pleasure of dedicating my 2 month old niece - Eden Amari John - the second child of my sister, at the churc where I was dedicated as a baby. Grateful to God for the privilege of blessing my family in this very special way.

I'm now about to board the first of three legs to PDX. As a "third-culture-kid" whose home is in the "hyphen," I'm grateful for the last few weeks of spending time with my immediate family, something that I get to do once a year if that.

Thank you for your patience, your kind and encouraging texts, and your prayers. I am looking forward to being back at Sunnyside and jumping full swing into our upcoming youth mission trip, summer evangelistic series, and camp meeting..

..but not after I give my wife a big fat hug and a kiss at the airport 😊

Our history class meets on Tuesdays, at 7:00 pm, in the Youth Room.


This week we will be studying "Jerusalem, An Introduction to the City" and "The Jerusalem of David and Solomon."


