Hello church family!

A thought crossed my mind the other day, "Once the sun starts to come out more things are going to get better." I'm not sure what I was hoping to get "better" but I realized that I say that to myself a lot. If x happens then things will finally be better, yet that situation rarely happens. Do you do the same thing? If I can finally have

kids, or if I pass that test, or get the promotion, or finally retire, then things will finally get better. I wonder if we do this because we are fearful of failure. If only I get through this, I won't feel like a failure anymore. We can restate it as "If x happens, then I will finally not feel like a failure anymore." Better then becomes feeling better about ourselves. Is this ringing true to you?

The only problem is that when we have kids, pass the test, get the promotion, or retire we now find new things that we can fail at. We find even more things that may make us feel like failures. For the last few months, Chelsea and I have been reading Bob Goff's daily devotional "Live in Grace, Walk in Love." It has been fantastic! He speaks right into these fears in our lives. He says, "Failure isn't part of life; it's much of life. The rest is just learning how to grow from it."

We end up failing to be patient with the people we love, or we fail to find the right words to give to someone in their moment of need. We fail our friends because we are too busy, we feel like we fail God when we keep on sinning and tripping on that one thing we wish God would just take away from us. We fail in keeping commitments. Failure then transitions from a one-time event to an ongoing reality that will make us better if we'll let it. Jesus continually showed kindness to people in the midst of their failures, and He always made a way for them to grow through them. Goff states, "there was always more grace then, and there is still more now."

Psalm 73:26 says, "My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is my strength of my heart and my portion forever." Next time we fail at something or if we fail someone, let's take a minute and instead of shaming or guilt-tripping ourselves let's try to find lessons it can teach us. It will make us wiser and I promise you it will give you more grace. What has been your biggest failure? Bring it to Jesus. Let His abundant grace wash over you and teach you how to learn from it!

Love you, church family! This seems hard, and experiencing our biggest failures may not be something you want to do, but I promise you that God is with you and it will only help you and those closest to you!
