Greetings church family!

I will never forget the first time I saw the old movie, "The Wizard of Oz." I was fascinated by all the strange characters, the struggle between good and evil ,and the yellow brick road. The green-skinned witch, the flying monkeys, a straw man, a tin man, a talking lion, and of course, wayward Dorothy and her little dog Toto.

I was young enough to be afraid of the flying monkeys but more terrified of the Great and Powerful Oz! The projection in the front of the great hall and the deep echoing voice had me put my hands over my face, peaking between fingers in hopes that Dorothy would somehow find her way home.
