Greetings church family,

The Crucifixion is not a defeat overturned by the Resurrection; the Crucifixion is a victory revealed by the Resurrection.

Seventh-day Adventists have long experienced an awkwardness with Easter Sunday. After all, it is on Sunday.

In one previous church I decided to hold a

sunrise service on Easter Sundays to meditate on the resurrection of Jesus. I had more than one church member corner me in my office complaining about the Catholic/pagan influences on the holiday and that we shouldn't have anything to do with it.

It happened that I was in some of these people's homes around Christmas time. They had Christmas trees all lit up and lights on the outside of their house. When I asked them about the pagan origins of Christmas, they didn't seem to be so concerned about those.

A few thoughts on Easter-

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most seminal moment of this earth's history. It changed everything. The power of death was defeated. The devil was punched in the nose. Humanity achieved victory in that one powerful act.

The resurrection is symbolic of the Christian life and our baptism. When we gave our lives to Christ our old selves were put to death and we were resurrected with Jesus into a new life that cannot be defeated by death. Not only is this true of the day we were baptized, it's true every day. Each day we die to self and come to life in Christ!

The Crucifixion is not a defeat overturned by the Resurrection; the Crucifixion is a victory revealed by the Resurrection! Ponder this. Meditate on it. And see what you come up with.

The devil revealed his character in fullness as Jesus was slaughtered on that cross. He used his agencies (the empire and religion) to take his wrath out on the Son of God. This demonstration of demonic wrath vs. the character of Jesus, who took on sin and suffering to save lost humanity, is all the evidence we need to see that love wins the day. The devil demands death. Jesus breathes new life. The devil kills. Jesus resurrects.

I for one, am thrilled that Easter Sunday comes around once a year to remind a dark world that there is light at the end of the tunnel. I'm glad that we take a day from each year (I know it's likely not the day that Jesus actually came out of the tomb, that that's okay with me) and celebrate Jesus. Happy Easter my friends!
