were presenting in 1941 had no idea the impact of that young 11year-old boy that year. The fact that he kept the bulletin must have meant that it was pivotal in his spiritual walk.

Then as you fast forward to my own growing up with Camp Meeting. Every year my family would take a 3day journey from Terrace, B.C. to Hope Camp Meeting in British Columbia. We faithfully made that long journey every year. It was a 2week commitment every


